Round 3:

- Left Side:** Cherokee Bluff (0).
- Right Side:** Brantley County (3).

Final: Westminster (Champion) vs. Brantley County (Runner-Up).

In the first four rounds, the higher-seeded team will host. If both teams are the same seed, a "universal" GHSA coin flip will determine the host school. In case of a rain-out at the State Site in the Finals, the higher-seeded team will be the host school (The "universal" GHSA coin flip will determine the host school if both teams are the same seed.)
