1. **Proposal** to amend the Preamble to the GHSA By-Laws on page 14 of the Constitution by adding a new subparagraph "D" to read as follows: "Nothing in the By-Laws of the GHSA is intended to give any individual students of GHSA member schools any due process or other rights as only member schools are entitled to any notice or opportunity to be heard in any questions coming before the GHSA. No student of GHSA member schools shall have any rights or benefits under these By-Laws as a third party beneficiary or otherwise." (GHSA Office)

2. **Proposal** to amend Article IV, Section 9 on page 12 of the GHSA Constitution by adding a new subparagraph "J" to read as follows: "Nothing in the Constitution of the GHSA is intended to give any individual students of GHSA member schools any due process or other rights as only member schools are entitled to any notice or opportunity to be heard in any questions coming before the GHSA. No student of GHSA member schools shall have any rights or benefits under this Constitution as a third party beneficiary or otherwise." (GHSA Office)
