Proposal to amend Article IV, Section 9 on page 12 of the GHSA Constitution by adding a new subparagraph "J" to read as follows: "Nothing in the Constitution of the GHSA is intended to give any individual students of GHSA member schools any due process or other rights as only member schools are entitled to any notice or opportunity to be heard in any questions coming before the GHSA. No student of GHSA member schools shall have any rights or benefits under this Constitution as a third party beneficiary or otherwise." (GHSA Office)

NOTE: This is a constitutional change and requires two votes. This is the second vote. The Board of Trustees passed the proposal unanimously in the first vote on Sept. 8, 2021.
