Championship Events – Over the last 5 years, payouts to schools from championship events has averaged \$1,121,108 annually.

This is our fifth-year waiving dues and catastrophic insurance for our member schools – an average approximately \$315,084 per year - \$198,609 of that figure is for catastrophic insurance.

GHSA currently pays \$625,000 per year for catastrophic insurance on behalf of our member schools.

Over the last three years, GHSA has paid the member schools a total of \$927,275 in member shares. We plan to pay a member share in September of this year equivalent to \$335,440.

PPT SLIDES ON POST SEASON RANKING FORMULA AND COMPETITIVE BALANCE

The GHSA is a private organization made up of approximately 470 member schools.

The objective of the GHSA organization shall be the promotion of education in Georgia from a mental, physical, and moral viewpoint, to standardize and encourage participation in athletics, and to promote sportsmanship and an appreciation for and study of music, speech, and other fine arts through Region and State competitions.

Any of our member schools may initiate a rule or bylaw that would be voted on by our executive committee which then makes it into the bylaws.

We are a member of the NFHS. The NFHS is important, because it sets the rules for all the events that we choose to participate in. As an organization choose to be a member NFHS and follow their rules.

Post Season Ranking

Public and Non-Public Schools in Classes A DI, 2A and 3A will play in their assigned regions during the regular season, but private member schools will compete in a combined championship bracket of private member schools only. Public schools in Class A DI, 2A and 3A will participate in a separate championship bracket by assigned classification. The following format will be used for playoff seeding sports where the ranking formula is required.

<u>Post Season Ranking Formula</u> (Public and Private Schools)

PSRF = (WP*0.35) + (OWP*0.35) + (OOWP*0.30)

WP - Winning Percentage

OWP - Opponents' Winning Percentage against GHSA opponents only

OOWP - Opponents' Opponents' Winning Percentage against GHSA opponents only

WP – is calculated by taking a team's wins divided by the number of contests it has played. Home win equals 0.9, Away win equals 1.1, neutral site and non GHSA opponents win is 1.

OWP – is calculated by taking the average of the WP's for each of the team's GHSA opponents with the requirement that all contests against the team in question are removed from the equation.

OOWP – is calculated by taking the average of each GHSA Opponent's OWP. Note that the team in question is part of the team's OOWP.

Post-Season Ranking Formula Examples

Team A loses to Team B at home

Team A wins against Team B on the road Team A loses to Team C on the road Team A is 1-2 Examples:

Team A loses a home game, wins an away game, and loses an away game.

WP = 1.1 (away win) / (1.1 (away game) + 1.1 (away game) + 0.9 (home game) = 0.35483

Team A has played Team B twice and Team B WP would be counted twice. Team A has played Team C once and Team C WP would be counted once.

OWP = (0/1 + 0/1 + 2/2) / 3 (number of opponents- Team B, Team B, Team C) OWP = 0.3333 OOWP = (Team B's OWP + Teams B's OWP + Team C's OWP) / 3.

OOWP = (0.000 + 0.000 + 0.500) / 3 = 0.1667

Team A's PSRF = (WP * 0.25) + (OWP * 0.50) + (OOWP * 0.25) Team A's PSRF = (0.35483 * 0.35) + (0.33333 * 0.35) + (0.16667 * 0.30) = 0.29086

HOW?

At the end of the determined period each schools GHSA points will be based upon the total 2 year average of GHSA Pts for all GHSA sports (excluding One Act, Game Day Cheer, Riflery, Literary, E-Sports, Slow Pitch Softball, Gymnastics and Bass Fishing)

The schools in each classification with the top 5 most points would be move up in the next reclass cycle and the bottom 5 schools would be moved down a classification.
